Minimum Requirements for the Position

1. Registered nurse currently registered in North Carolina with an unencumbered license and two years of work experience. Degree must be from a regionally accredited institution
2. Must meet **one** of the following: completion of a course in teaching adults, experience in teaching adults, or experience in supervising nurse aides
3. Willingness to work irregular hours including nights and weekends, as needed
4. Exceptional interpersonal relations skills
5. Excellent communication skills (oral and written)
6. Ability to work well without close supervision
7. Desire to use or learn to use technology (i.e. Internet) to deliver instruction
8. Willingness to be a productive team player
9. Commitment to the community college "open door" philosophy and the comprehensive community college concept.

Primary Function of the Position

Provide classroom, campus lab and clinical site instruction as required in the continuing education Nurse Aide courses.

A completed Southeastern Community College application, a resume, and educational transcripts (unofficial copies of transcripts will be sufficient for the screening process, but official copies must be submitted prior to employment) must be submitted to the college Human Resources Office in order for applicants to be considered for this position. Applications will be accepted until position(s) are filled.
