

We are so glad you are continuing your education at SCC! Complete the following steps to register for classes.

- Complete the NC Residency application. This application determines in-state or out-of-state status for tuition purposes. For more information regarding residency or to complete your residency determination, visit <https://ncresidency.cfnc.org>.
  - Login using your existing CFNC login.
  - Be sure to read carefully and answer questions accurately.
  - Most students need the following information to complete the RDS application: parent(s)', spouse(s)' and student's social security number, residence information, federal and state tax return, vehicle registration, and driver's license number.
- Re-apply to SCC. Submit an application online at [www.sccnc.edu](http://www.sccnc.edu), click "Apply." On page three, or Enrollment Information, select "Freshman" for enrollment type.
- Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) online at [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov). SCC's school code is: 002964. Assistance is available in the Financial Aid office in A-Building. Be sure to check your financial status in WebAdvisor.
- Complete the SCC scholarship application for local scholarships, including the Success Scholarship.
- Request official high school transcript to be sent to SCC.
- If required, schedule to take the placement assessment. Pre-nursing, Medical Lab Technology, and Phlebotomy students are required to take the math placement test.

What happens next?

- Meet with an SCC Student Services staff member and register for classes.
- Check in with the SCC Financial Aid Office to complete the financial aid process (even though you may have received a confirmation email from FAFSA) or to ensure payment arrangements have been made.
- Attend a SOAR event (Student Orientation & Academic Readiness).
